It was difficult working in two schools last term, however it did give me an insight into the issues that needed to be tackled at St Blasius before I officially started and allowed me to do much of the forward planning.

It will be fair to say the school has gone through a few turbulent years, however the ship is now stable. Those who have been around the school will notice the changes being made in facilities. The new library area is nearly finished. The locked garden area will soon be open to add an outdoor teaching and play area. A lawn has been created at the top end and Mr Bolt and the Gardening Club are planting the lower end of the Garden and the front of the School. However, whilst welcome, new facilities do not make schools outstanding. The School's clear focus has been on improving teaching and learning. They are a joy to work with and to talk to. As parents you should be very proud.


