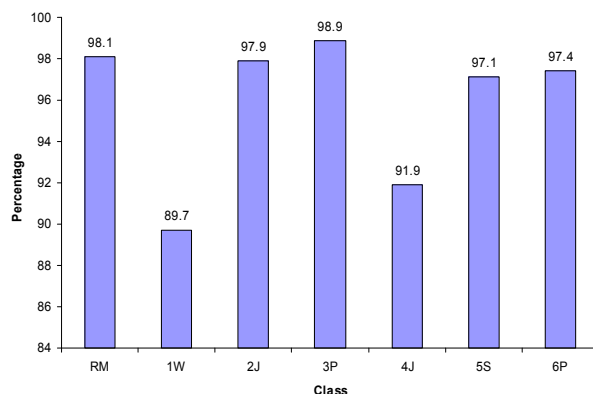
Staff Leavers
