Parents are invited to join Year 5 and 6 in attending a short Remembrance Service at St Blasius Church, Shanklin at 1.30pm .

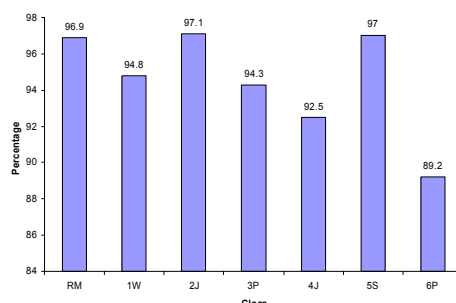


Data Checking Sheets
