Well done to Year 6 pupils for their excellent conduct and effort during their SATS, and to all the other pupils for working so hard in the different tests/assessments they have done this week.



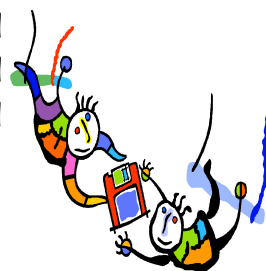
Schools Walk the Wight
