Pupil Achievement Results School Year Sept 2012 – July 2013

End of Foundation Stage

At the end of the Foundation Stage the percentage of our children who achieved the 'expected' Level were:

64% Reading 57% Writing 68% Maths

End of Key Stage One

At the end of the Infant Stage, the percentage of our children who achieved the nationally expected Level 2 were:

87% Reading 87% Writing 87% Maths

End of Key Stage Two

At the end of the Junior Stage in Year 6, the percentage of our children who achieved the nationally expected Level 4 were:

86% Reading 73% Writing 86% Maths At the end of Year 1, the percentage of children who achieved the nationally expected Level of 80% was 54%.

Pupil Premium Sept 2012 – July 2013

Pupil Premium Funding is received by all schools nationally for the children in receipt of either Free School Meals or who have a parent serving in the Armed Forces or are fostered, known nationally as 'Looked After'.

In our school this amounts to 25.6% of our children and we received an additional allowance of £60,000.00 to support their needs academically and socially.

Of our Pupil Premium children

62% achieved in line with the national expectation for reading 46% achieved in line with the national expectation for writing 49% achieved in line with the national expectation for maths

Pupil Premium: 2013 - 2014

The anticipated income for this current school year will continue to be around £60,000.00. We will be using the money to target support and intervention programmes in order for children to achieve more closely with national expectations.

We were disappointed by last year's achievement levels and this year we will be working hard to reduce the 'gap' of attainment for all our children in reading, writing and maths.
